David's Heart

The Lord told Samuel that He was selecting a new king from among the sons of Jesse. Samuel thought Eliab, Jesse's eldest, would be Jehovah's choice because of his physical appearance. God selected David explaining that He "looks at the heart" (1 Sam. 16:7). Paul referred to this saying, "... God gave testimony and said, 'I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all my will'" (Acts 13:22). In contrast, King Saul was rejected because he had a rebellious and stubborn heart that disobeyed the Lord's command (1 Sam. 15:22, 23).

Nineteen rulers of Judah are listed in the books of Kings. David's heart was the standard for all of these kings. Jehovah told Solomon, "If you walk before me as your father David walked, in integrity of heart and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded you, ... then I will establish the throne of your kingdom over Israel forever" (1 Kings 9:4, 5). Later, the Lord rebuked Solomon: "You have not walked in My ways to do what is right in My eyes... as did your father David" (1 Kings 11:33). Jeroboam was also chastised, "You have not been as My servant David, who kept my commandments..." (1 Kings 14:8). It was recorded about Abjiam whose "...heart was not loyal to the Lord his God, as was the heart of his father David" (1 Kings 15:3). This summary was stated about David's life: "He did what was right in the eyes of the Lord... all the days of his life, except in the matter of Uriah the Hittite" (1 Kings 15:5).

David's heart revealed the deep character that the Lord saw. He was a good and honest man who did not resist Divine command. When Saul threatened to take David's life, he was not vengeful. The Psalms reveal that he was seeking to know Jehovah and desired a closer relationship with Him. David sought to build a magnificent temple for the Lord because he wanted the name of the Lord exalted. He refused to serve idols and drove out every place of idol worship. David committed grievous sin with Bathsheba and killed her husband, yet he sincerely repented of it. He was one who constantly depended on the Lord for his help. The Almighty saw all of these characteristics when He looked upon David's heart and selected him as king of Israel.

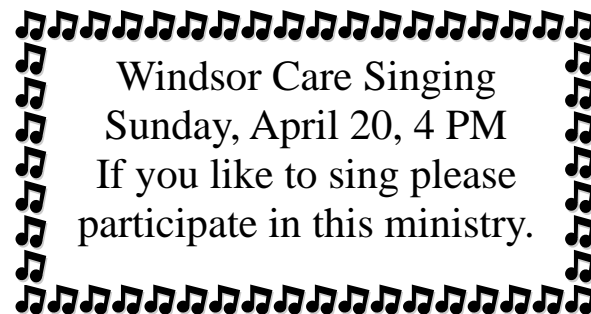
Youth News
