Everyone of us enjoys having our name written somewhere. When an important social event takes place in the community we all like for our name to be on the invitation list. We all consider it a wonderful acknowledgement to receive a plaque with our name engraved upon it. Those of you who play sports would be greatly honored to have your name recorded in a hall of fame. The highest honor our name can receive is attained when it is listed on heaven’s roll.

In Revelation, John described his vision of the holy city, the new Jerusalem. He spoke of its beauty, magnificence, security, and glory. He revealed that **“only those who are written in the Lamb’s Book of Life will enter this city.” (Revelation 21:27)**. The Hebrew writer denotes the privileges that Christians have under the New Covenant. One of these is that we **“are registered in heaven...” (Hebrews 12:23)**.
