

Your Life is Readable

Paul reminded the saints at Corinth that they were “known and read by all men” (2 Cor. 3:2). The community knew what the apostles taught and how Christ’s followers lived. God’s message was seen in their lives.

The visibility of our behavior is not a new message because Jesus taught in the Sermon on the Mount, “You are the light of the world, a city set on a hill cannot be hidden” (Matt. 5:14). Our behavior and speech reveals a message written on our hearts (2 Cor. 3:3). One way or another we tell those around us that Christ is our Lord or that possessions and sports rule our life; that we are concerned about people going to heaven or that we care only about ourselves; that we are a poor imitation of our Savior or others see that Jesus lives in us. Poet Edgar A. Guest wrote,

*“The lectures you deliver may be wise and true,
But I’d rather get my lesson by observing what you do.
For I may misunderstand you and the high advice you give,
But there’s no misunderstanding how you act and live!”*

These thoughtful words cause us to realize that individuals watch our manner of life.

Paul told members of the church that the people around them were reading their lives. When our neighbors finish examining our conduct, what are they going to say about what they see? Our challenge is to live in such a way that clearly reveals Jesus dwelling in us, thereby making others receptive to the Savior.

We are deeply saddened by the passing of our sister **Emma Moore** early Thursday morning. She has been a mainstay of this congregation for many years. *She and Vernon* were among the original members of the Queen Street congregation. We will remember Emma for her faithful devotion to the Lord’s church. She loved being at worship with the family of God and was truly an inspiration to all of us. We will miss her. Let’s remember **Brenda** as she mourns the loss of her dear mother.
